DAY ACTIVITIES

DAY 1 iSimangaliso Wetland Park

Check into the Safari Lodge

Gather for a briefing with your guide and get ready for a 2hr Sunset Boat Cruise on the St Luda Estuary to witness Hippo's, Nile Crocodiles and a wide variety of Estuarine Birds. After your dinner, you are off on a 2,5hr Night Drive into the iSimangaliso Wetland Park.

DAY 2 Open Vehicle Safari

5am start to your day on Open game drive vehicle safari, you are transferred to the Umfolozi Game Reserve on the Southern section of Hluhluwe - Umfolozi Game Reserve.

We'll set up breakfast in the bush. See the abundance of animal life in this area. Against a backdrop of rolling hills, thick bush and open plains, the Big 5 await you, Impala scatter and Giraffe frolic in the open plains.

Travel with your knowledgeable guide, taking time to find and observe the exciting wildlife here. Lunch is a traditional South African barbeque lunch in the bush or a picnic lunch if inclement weather.

DAY 3 Bush & Beach Experience

A later start today, 8am pick up as we head up to Cape Vidal on the lookout for marine life and the Samango Monkeys that are prevalent here. The entire area is a World Heritage Site and offers one grasslands, mangroves, vegetated dunes and pristine beaches.

Snorkel in the protected bay (this activity is weather and low tide permitting), discovering stunning tropical fish species, hidden coves, and game fish.

Stop for a picnic and witness the endangered Samango Monkeys.

After the excursion, you will be transferred to Durban airport for your flight home.

St Lucia—Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Game Park

About 240 kilometres from Durban in northern KwaZulu Natal, forms part of the iSimangaliso Wetland Park and its estuary has one of the highest concentrations of hippos and crocodiles in Southern Africa.

What also makes this area magnificent is that the park is South Africa's first World Heritage Site and includes nine per cent of the country's coastline.
